## MAPS

*The following two lots are 2<sup>nd</sup> World War military maps featuring Singapore. Nearly all came from the papers of Major R.E. Farmer, Royal Engineers, who was involved in planning for the re-occupation of Malaya. Three duplicates of these maps were offered M.S.G. March 1998 but a recent acquisition of a couple of maps from the papers of Colonel Pennicuick (of B.M.A. postmark fame!) who served during the Emergency has allowed completion of the set of nine maps in the 2<sup>nd</sup> lot.*

*All maps are large folding maps marked "RESTRICTED" which would have curtailed their distribution in the first place. The shortage of everything in 1945 is reflected in that two of the set of nine are photo-litho copies of the same quality, etc., but in 'greyscale' rather than colour. That these two groups of maps have only come from the papers of these two senior officers perhaps explains why these are the only ones seen by vendor over a period of 20 years.*

- 265 **Singapore & Johore Bahru:** Hind 1035 sheet 3 L/12 4<sup>th</sup> edition in colour, 1 Inch to 1 Mile, Published by Survey Production Centre ALFSEA 1945, Revised 7 Ind Air Survey Coy, Reproduced by 110 Map production Coy R.E. June 1945. This map is an overview of the whole of Singapore, its southern islands and the adjoining Johore territory based on Survey Dept. Maps until 1941, revised from aerial photography Nov. 1944. Includes Tengah, Sembawang, Kallang & Paya Lebar airfields, the last marked 'Under Construction', Floating Dock, etc., plus all the expected civilian features. Approx 32x24 inches in size, made to fold in to 21. Apart from a sealed marginal tear fine & very fresh condition. This was the finer of the two examples in the Major Farmer papers, the other example realised £155 in 1998. A rare & useful map which appears not to have been replaced until 1953 when a new edition is known to exist. £120

- 266 **Singapore & Johore Bahru:** Hind 610 1<sup>st</sup> Edition, overview of Singapore & adjoining Johore territory in a set of nine large folding maps, circa 25x20 inches, Scale 1:25000(2.53 inches to 1 mile). Published Survey Production Centre South East Asia 1945, Revised 7 Ind Air Survey Coy, Reproduced by 71 Rep. Sec. R.E. August 1945. The North West corner map titled Johore Bahru West(mainly remote Johore but includes Tanjong Bungah, mouth of Sungei Kranji), & the South West corner map titled KG. TG. Balai(mainly remote territory, islands off Sungei Jurong,) are both printed in greyscale to same quality as other maps but the other seven are each colour printed. Maps are folded in to 4 or 8 except “Singapore Main” which is folded into six panels. These maps have been used and there is some slight soiling or ageing here or there, one of the greyscale maps has one sixteenth that appears to have had a slight argument with a cup of coffee but overall good condition. This must be a very rare set of maps and a valuable reference to how Singapore (& the near Johore coast) was in 1945. Ex. Farmer & Pennicuick. Two duplicates Ex Major Farmer each realised £76 in 1998.
