Included also are blocks of all values (except the \$2) as follows: 10c – marginal block of 4 with imprint; 12c – marginal pair with imprint; 25c – marginal block of 4 with imprint; 30c ditto; 40c – top L/H corner pair; 50c – marginal block of 4 with imprint; \$1 ditto; \$5 – marginal pair with imprint. The \$2 is missing because the vendor never found a block which matched his standards. In his view this set of stamps is magnificent and not to be compromised by even a suspicion of toning. The buyer must continue the search! Cat. £990. **250**
- 339** 1937. Airmail cover bearing two Halimshah 10c (SG 60) & a 5c, from Serdang to UK 9.7.37. **25**
- 340** 1939. Surface cover to USA bearing a Halimshah 12c (SG 61) from Sungei Patani 28.1.39 **30**
- 341** 1937. Airmail cover to UK bearing a Halimshah 25c (SG 62) from Alor Star 19.8.37. Slight damage on opening at top. **25**
- 342P** 1939. Airmail censored cover to Hong Kong bearing a Halimshah 25c & a 30c (SG 62 & 63) from Alor Star 31.10.39 **50**
- 343P** 1940. Airmail censored cover to UK bearing a Halimshah 40c & 5cx3 (SG 64 & 55) from **50**

Gurun 28.5.40.

- 344** 1940. Airmail censored cover to UK bearing a Halimshah 50c (SG 65) from Sungei Patani on 8.5.40. **25**
- 345P** 1941. Clipper cover to UK bearing a pair of Halimshah \$1 (SG 66) from Sungei Patani on 1.10.41. Cover also bears a RAF/Censor/47 mark. **50**
- 346P** 1941. Clipper cover to UK bearing a Halimshah \$2 (SG 67) from Indian FPO 36 which was at Sungei Patani. Cover also bears a military censor. **100**
- 347P** Sultan Abdul Hamid Halimshah 1937 Revenue. A single mint copy of the \$25 black & dark red which, though toned, is well above average for this stamp and looks fine from the front. Also colour photographs of the only known lower R/H corner blocks of all 3 values of the set: \$25, \$100 & \$500. **20**
- 348P** 1933. Official Post Card. The Kedah government produced post cards for use by their departments and this one was sent by the Superintendent P & T Dep. requesting settlement of a monthly telephone account. Posted in Alor Star on 2.9.33 it was received in Kuala Nerang on the 4th. Unfortunately the mark is too faint to pick out anything other than the 'K'. Two file holes have been filled in but otherwise is in fairly good condition. **40**
- 349** An 'Avis De Reception/Advice of Delivery' card sent from & to Kuala Nerang on 28.2.38. This means there is a Kuala Nerang strike on both sides of the card which, though faint, are both readable. Two filled in file holes and very slightly toned but must be very scarce. **40**
- 350** A dozen or so album pages containing a few scattered postmarks nearly all on stamps, not pieces. This is not a cornucopia. The only items of note are a page bearing two part examples of the rare Padang Trap oval, a part Padang Lanjut & a part Kuala Nerang (explanation on album page). Also a block of 4 bearing the Sungei Patang forgery, an oval Bedong on piece and a creased Lunas cover **40**
- 351** Postmarks on cover. 1922. Small brown OGS envelope sent from the GPO in Alor Star to USA 19.7.22. A small d/r Superintendent's chop bottom left and a boxed 'On Postal Business only' cachet in black at top. The latter is the only example recorded (as far as it is known). **20**
- 352** Alor Star 1941. Cover franked 8c, SG 57, addressed to The Secretary, Malaya Industrial Fair, c/o Ibrahim Club, Kulim, from Alor Star 18.8.41. A neat, scarce internal Kedah cover. **20**
- 353** Baling 1919. An L.K. Seng cover franked Kedah 2cx2 + Straits 1c & 4c tied by clear Baling strikes d/d 6.10.19. A good Padang Serai oval on the reverse. **15**
- 354** Bandar Bharu 1936. Neat airmail cover to UK franked by a 'Malay-ploughing' 25c tied by a very good strike of Bandar Bharu d/d 14.3.36. **25**
- 355** Jitra 1939. Neat cover franked by a 5c, SG 55, tied by a very fine strike of Jitra d/d 2.10.39, addressed to Penang. An Alor Star b/s. **20**
- 356** Karangan 1939. A censored airmail cover to UK franked by a variety of padi-sheaf values amounting to 55c tied by 4 strikes of the Karangan cds d/d 28.11.39. Addressee's name blanked out & slight peripheral damage. **15**
- 357** Kuala Ketil 1924. A 10c registration envelope bearing padi-sheaf 1c black, 2c & 5c values **10**

- tied by good strikes of Kuala Ketil d/d 6.10.24, addressed to UK. Also a very clear strike of the K. Ketil registration cachet. Envelope damaged on opening but neatly repaired and also a central vertical fold.
- 358** Padang Serai 1920. Cover franked with a 4c rose, SG 20, tied by a clear Padang Serai cds d/d 26.11.20, & addressed to UK. Both the stamp and the cds are upside down. **15**
- 359** Semiling 1919. A neat registered L.K. Seng cover franked Kedah 2c & 3cx2 + Straits 1c & 4c tied by 3 strikes of the Semiling cds d/d 2.10.19. Cover also bears a good strike of the Semiling registration cachet. **20**
- 360** Serdang 1931. A cover franked with a 4c purple, SG 54, tied by an inverted Serdang cds d/d 27.11.31, addressed to UK where it was re-directed. A Bandar Bharu b/s. **10**
- 361** Sungei Patani 1928. A registered cover franked 1c (damaged) & 4cx5 purple tied by two Sungei Patani cdss d/d 1.12.28 & addressed to UK. Sungei Patani reg. label attached. **20**
- 362** FPO S.P. 503 1941. A censored airmail cover to the UK franked with a pair of 8c, SG 57, & a block of 4 of the Sultan Halimshah 10c, SG 60, cancelled by two strikes of the FPO S.P. 503 cds d/d 21.4.41. Attractive & scarce. **50**
- 363** FPO 31 1941. A twice censored airmail cover to India franked with a Sultan Halimshah 25c, SG 62, cancelled by an FPO 31 cds d/d 21.1.41. Also a similar cancel on a piece d/d 4.3.41. **30**
- 364** FPO 36 1941. A censored airmail cover to India franked by a Sultan Halimshah 25c, SG 62, cancelled by an FPO 36 cds d/d 4.7.41. Also a similar cancel on a block of 4 of the 5c, SG 55, d/d 7.8.41. **20**
- 365** Japanese Occupation. Two album pages of stamps with the Dai Nippon 2602 o/p. The first bears 1c, 2c, 4c & 5c padi-sheafs & 10c, 12c, 25c & 50c of the Sultan Halimshah set, all mint, plus 2cx2, 5cx2 & 8c padi-sheafs and the 10cx2, 30c & 50c of the Sultan Halimshah set, all used and all probably genuine. The second page bears 1c, 4c, 5c, 6c (both types) & 8cx2 padi-sheaf values, mint, plus two other 4c used, also the 10c, 12c, 25c & 40c of the Sultan Halimshah set, mint, all of which the vendor strongly suspects are forged, especially as the 1940 6c has a double overprint, one black & one red! Also one or two inconsequential items. Cat. c£415 **75**
- 366** Siamese Occupation. An album page bearing 5 stamps of the 1944 Siamese general issue depicting the war memorial, all with Kedah postmarks. The five are made up of two 2c, a 4c & two 8c (one of which shows a complete Gurun postmark on piece). Cat. £108 **25**
- 367P** Siamese Occupation. The 10c revenue stamp inscribed Syburi lithographed on light blue paper, roughly perforated and without gum. Cat. £? **20**
- 368** BMA. Free Post Period. Cover postmarked Kulim dated 9.10.45 (a pre-war cancel but fair only) to an address in Kulim. Appears to be commercial. **20**
- 369** Siamese cancellations on BMA stamps. Six pieces each bearing BMA stamps all with Siamese cancels in temporary use in the early part of the BMA period. Three of the cancels are indecipherable; the others are Lunas, Baling (complete) & Bedong. **10**
- 370** Cover addressed to Evatt & Co., Penang, bearing a BMA 8c red tied by the undated Sungei Patani temporary canceller listed in Proud as D11 which was in use in 1946. Neat. **30**
- 371** Salvaged pre-war cancel. Airmail cover to UK bearing BMA 10c, 15c & 25c tied by two **10**

strikes of the pre-war Alor Star mark, Proud D13, d/d 26.9.47.

- 372** Salvaged pre-war cancel. Local cover addressed to Evatt & Co., Penang, franked by a BMA 8c red neatly cancelled by the pre-war Kuala Ketil postmark in violet listed by Proud as D3. There is a m/s date of 30/10 in the centre & Proud says this postmark was in use in 1946 **20**
- 373** Philatelic cover addressed to T.S. Tay Singapore, bearing 1c, 3c, 6c & 8c BMA stamp cancelled by two strikes of the s/l Post Office/Serdang mark (dated in m/s 27.10.45) listed by Proud as D5 and described, curiously, as a Japanese Occupation cancellation. **10**
- 374** Cover addressed to Evatt & Co., Penang, franked by a BMA 8c red tied by the s/l canceller of P. Serai P.O. with a m/s date below of 17.12.46. Neat, clean item. **15**
- 375** BMA period postmarks. Two album pages bearing a dozen (all different) s/r postmarks 29mm in diameter with date & time in a single ring & all on piece. 11 are complete. Before Proud these were known as Type 29t. The second page bears another dozen (all complete except for one) of the 26mm s/r type without the time, customarily used on registered Also a m/c of Alor Star on piece and a triangular printed matter cancel containing SP (Sungei Patani) complete on piece. 26 items. **10**
- 376** BMA cover. A registered Chetty cover from Alor Star addressed to Chengkat Tok Ramat, Mukim Jeram, in Kedah bearing, on reverse, BMA 2c + 25cx2 stamps cancelled 7.10.46. On the front there is a m/s 'Retour' and (in red ink) a m/s 'Beyond Postal Delivery Retour'. On the reverse is written in Malay and dated 16.10.46 (by the postman?) what could be translated as 'This place can't go it located far journey'. Research shows two other covers (both pre-war) known similarly treated. A most interesting item which, though a Chetty, is not toned. **20**
- 377** Stationery. A pre-occupation p/s 4c purple card of Johore which has been demonetised by what looks like a Benta chop, 25c of BMA stamps added & cancelled by a RAF POST OFFICE 155c ds d/d 13.3.46, & sent airmail to Finland. There is some doubt about where this post office was based at this time, Penang or Kedah, but the balance of evidence seems to suggest Kedah. Fine **20**
- 378** Two album pages, the 1st bearing two registered airmail covers from Alor Star to Haadyai both franked by BMA 10c & 25c stamps, cancelled 17.8.48 & 1.9.48. Also an air letter franked by a BMA 25c from Kulim 22.3.50. As sold at the time by the post offices? Good condition **10**
- 379** Silver Wedding 1948. An album page bearing mint & used copies of the SW set, SG 70 & 71, plus a commercial cover showing the 10c used from Alor Star to Penang 3.5.49. Cat.£78 **15**
- 380** UPU issue 1949. Five album pages, the first bearing a mint set and a reg. cover from Sungei Patani to UK on 23.11.49 franked with the set and bearing the temporary registration cachet Proud lists as R4, the date of which is extended by this cover. The other pages each bear a mint or marginal block of each of the 4 values, two used copies and a commercial cover showing the correct use of the value. Cat. £38 plus the covers. **15**
- 381** Sultan Badlishah. An unused post card on the back of which is written: 'H.H. Sultan of Kedah with Barrett (B.A.) in background, at opening of Badlishah Bridge at Alor Star in **10**

January '56.'

- 382** 1950-55. A study of the Kedah 'smalls' SG 76-90, on 23 pages, the first two bearing the mint set and a FDC franked 1c-4c. The 21 values occupy the rest, one page for each value. There are 29 blocks of 4, mainly plate blocks but a few pairs. Innumerable used – too numerous to count or value but all with Kedah postmarks and, where the dates are visible, used in period, while avoiding heavy marks – and no cto. The \$2 is represented by two pairs (both corners, one plate) and 4 used the \$5 by a corner block of 4 and a plate pair and 3 used. The emphasis at all times is on fine condition. Cat. value must be well over £1,000 so a snip at **200**
- 383** 1950-55. An imperf, without gum, bottom marginal block of 4 of the 8c green on buff paper, sometimes described as a proof but really printer's waste. **20**
- 384** 1950. The \$25 red & brown of the Sultan Badlishah revenue set used. The stamp is pin-perforated '50', has a light pen mark and an unobtrusive revenue cancel but, apart from one pulled perf at the top, is in fine condition with good colours. Scarce item. **25**
- 385** 1950-55. These are the covers which were originally part of Lot 182 but separated as few collectors seem to like mixing covers with stamps. All values of the set represented apart from the 40c & \$5 although the \$2 is used on a commercial cover from Penang. All the other covers have Kedah marks and are commercial. They include such gems such as the 8c red, 12c red & 20c black & green all properly used singly to frank these rates. Such things almost have rarity status now. 21 covers in all. **50**
- 386** 1950 Postal Stationery. 4 registration envelopes dating from the 1950-55 period, all fine used, as follows: Type 1, Size G, A. Star to Penang 22.11.52; Type 1, Size H2, from Sungei Patani to Alor Star 12.12.55; Type 1, Size H, from Kulim to A. Star 9.12.55; & Type 2, Size G, from A. Star to Kuala Lumpur 1.12.54. **30**
- 387** 1950 Postal Stationery. Two 4c brown p/s cards both fine used. The first uprated by 2cx2 orange, SG 77, used from A. Star to Ireland 3.3.52; the second uprated by the 2c red p.p.i. making the 6c rate from A. Star to Kuala Lumpur. **10**
- 388** 1950 Postal Stationery. The two different types of 10c brown p/s envelopes, both fine used. The first, produced by De La Rue (with a pointed flap) was registered from Kuala Ketil to Kuala Lumpur on 23.3.55; the second, produced by McCorquodale (with rounded flap), was sent from A. Star to Ipoh on 11.11.55. Neither are easy to find used **20**
- 389** 1950 Postal Stationery. Four air letters produced in conjunction with the 1950-55 set of stamps, all bearing a 25c adhesive, SG 85, two uprated with the 5c p.p.i. in red (one mint, one used) and two without. Of the latter, one has just has AIR LETTER in its inscription; the second has AEROGRAMME/AIR LETTER in two lines. Fine. **15**
- 390** 1957. The 'Independence' pictorial issue featuring Sultan Badlishah, SG 92-102, on 12 album pages. The first page shows the set mint, the next 10 bear the stamps in plate blocks of 4, apart from the 20c which is in a block of 10. Also two used copies of each of the values 1c-50c and one copy of each of the dollar values which are all used on piece. The last page bears a mint post card showing a Malay farmer ploughing a padi-field backed by background information on the design which, of course, is a famous one in Kedah. Cat. £600+ **100**
- 391** 1957 issue. A small bundle of 8 covers (taken from the pages in the previous lot) bearing the 1c, 2c, 4c, 5c, 10c, 20c, 50c & \$1 values of the Sultan Badlishah set. Covers bearing **15**

these stamps are now difficult to find.

- 392** 1959 pictorial issue featuring Sultan Abdul Halimshah, SG 104-114, on 14 album pages, the first bearing the set with all perforation variations - mint. The others the set in blocks, corner or marginal as follows: 1c (4 & 3), 2c (4), 4c (4), 5c (4), 8c (6), 10c brown (4), 10c maroon (10 - bottom two rows – now cat £14 each), 20c (6), 50c (two corner blocks of 4), \$1 (4), \$2 (6), & \$5 (two blocks of 6). Also a minimum of two used copies of each value but 3 of the \$2, 3 of the \$5 (perf 12½) and 4 of the \$5 perf variety, all used properly in Kedah. There is also an off-set of the 4c value. Cat. £830+ . **120**
- 393** 1959 issue. A small bundle of 12 covers (taken from the pages in Lot 192) bearing the 1c, 2c, 4c, 5c, 8c, both 10c, 20c, both 50c, & \$1 values of the Sultan Abdul Halimshah set. **20**
- 394** 1959 issue. A1957 'map' 20c + 10c registration envelope uprated by a \$1 & a \$2 (SG 112 & 113) on the front and a further 5c value on the back, to pay the airmail rate from Alor Star to USA on 27.7.62. A nice clean item and the only commercial cover on which the vendor says he has seen this \$2 (in 50 years). **20**
- 395** Postal Stationery. The 'tiger head' 10c p/s envelope uprated by a pair of the 20c (SG 110) used Changloon to Bangkok on 6.12.60. A scarce envelope used in the northern states, especially in this condition. **10**
- 396** Postal Stationery. Eight album pages with 'national' p/s items used in Kedah, starting with the two 6c cards, the first (inscriptions in English) used Bedong 11.4.59, the second (uprated to 10c & inscriptions in Malay) used A. Star 22.9.65. Two different 25c 'tin dredge' air letters & 3 different 30c 'map' air letters; two different shades (white & cream) of the 10c+20c 'map' registration envelopes, Size G; similar type envelopes Sizes H & H2 both bearing a pair of supplementary 20c definitives, the first SG 98, the second SG 110; the Federation of Malaya 40c+10c reg. envelope, Size G, used 3.8.65, each and every one used in Kedah; also a Kedah McCorquodale 20c reg. envelope, Size G, used 23.8.57 in Gurun. 13 items. Maybe a unique and unrepeatable lot. **20**
- 397** Postmarks 1961/62. An album page bearing 3 philatelic covers all to do with the agency Relau. Although in Kedah it was served by Sungei Bakap in Penang but there is also a Relau on Penang Island and this caused confusion, with the result that the first Relau postmark had the state name of Penang. A subsequent skeleton corrected the error and the three covers (each bearing a pair of 2c orange pineapples) record these events. A curiosity and interesting. **15**
- 398** Miscellaneous. Five album pages, the first bearing a plate block of 4 of the 1953 QE coronation issue together with a local cover and used copies; the second ditto of the 1959 Sultan installation 10c including two copies with what appear to be retouches on the plate; the other 3 pages with pieces and covers of the Malayan Federation issue, SG 1-4, and various national commemoratives issued 1957-63, all used in Kedah. The latter include the World Refugee Year 1960 commemorative air letter. **10**
- 399** The Kedah book. Never been opened. **10**
